



Flat refurbishments in Kilkeel

The Northern Ireland Housing Executive (www.nihe.gov.uk) has started a major improvement scheme for six flats in Slieveshan Park, Kilkeel at a total cost of £218,000. The interiors of the flats will be completely re-arranged to provide an additional bedroom, a new heating system, as well as new kitchen and bathroom facilities. Ravarnet homes to be modernised

The Northern Ireland Housing Executive (www.nihe.gov.uk) has announced the start of a £500,000 scheme to refurbish 13 homes in Ravarnet. An investment of approximately £530,000 will bring these properties up to modern standards and will provide new kitchens, bathrooms, doors and windows and oil fired heating systems. High level improvements at New Lodge

The multi-storey flats at New Lodge are to get high level improvements through a major improvement scheme costing over £750,000. The seven blocks of flats, which are a North Belfast landmark, were built in the 1960s and work is being carried out as part of the Northern Ireland Housing Executive's (www.nihe.gov.uk) Planned Maintenance Programme. This ensures that homes are upgraded on a regular basis and continue to meet modern day standards. Among the many refurbished facilities and fabrics to be provided, communal aerial/satellite facilities will be provided at each floor to facilitate the removal of all external aerials prior to work on the external facades commencing. Power and water facilities will also be provided at each floor.

£1.5m investment in Carrickfergus homes

Two major Northern Ireland Housing Executive (www.nihe.gov.uk) contracts, representing investment of more than £1.5m will benefit 58 tenants in the Carrickfergus district. £11m funding boost for Inverclyde

River Clyde Homes is to receive over £11m in grant funding to help improve housing in Inverclyde. The Scottish Government has announced it expects £493m to be spent across the country as part of the Housing Association Grant

Homes in Parkgate to benefit from £1m improvements

£4.2m affordable homes for East Lothian

Work is due to begin on the construction of 52 new affordable houses in East Lothian after the £4.2m contract was approved by East Lothian Council. Fifty-two houses will be built on a site at West Windygoul, Tranent. Previously known as 'Plot D', the area will be known as Baxter's Gate. The completed development will comprise a mix of different-sized properties - from one-bedroom flats to three bedroom houses, as well as two bungalows specifically designed for wheelchair users. 72 affordable homes for Dunfermline & Rosyth

The Fife Housing Association Alliance is to build 72 new affordable homes in Rosyth and Dunfermline as part of an £8.3m investment. The first project, at Castle Road, Rosyth, is on site and nearing completion, where Kingdom Housing Association is developing 34 new homes in a £3.8m development. Funding approval has also recently been obtained for the latest project in Dunfermline, where 38 new affordable houses will be developed at Linburn Road, Dunfermline. The project, to cost £4.5m, will be constructed by Mansells Partnership, and will provide both family and special needs houses. Works will be completed in July 2009.

Big investment in Perthshire council houses

Over £64m is to be invested in council houses by Perth and Kinross Council over the next three years. Work will continue on a number of rolling improvement programmes, including replacing kitchens and bathrooms in all council houses, as well as a central heating replacement project. Jewel and Esk development

£43m housing regeneration for Glasgow

The final phases of West of Scotland Housing Association's £43m regeneration of Camlachie, home to 500 tenants at the heart of Glasgow's Commonwealth Games corridor, have been launched by Minister for Communities and Sport, Stewart Maxwell.
